Re: Local Disposal Option for Asphalt Shingles

Ellsworth Demo Disposal, 15 Industrial Road, Ellsworth (behind the Ellsworth transfer station) now accepts asphalt roofing shingles. The current disposal fee is \$75 a ton. Loads must be free of all contaminants and not contain any asbestos. The shingles are processed into pavement patching material. This is a privately owned operation that accepts most forms of Construction and Demolition Debris. It offers roll-off containers in 30, 40, and 50 cubic yard sizes and live floor trailers for large projects. Its operating hours are:

1. Between March 1 and November 30: Monday-Friday, 7:00 AM- 4:00 PM and Saturdays, 8:00 AM- 4:00 PM.
2. Between December 1 and March 1 Monday-Friday, 7:00 AM-4:00 PM Saturdays, 8:00 AM-12:00 PM.
