
Printing Maps from Adobe Acrobat

Option 1: Printing an entire map

- Select (click on) the map that you want to view and / or print. This should open in Adobe Acrobat within your internet browsing software.
- Select "File" then "Print" from your menu. If you do not see the "File" command, you may need to turn on the menu by clicking above the top of the map with the right (not left) mouse button. You may also click right mouse button anywhere on the map and find a "Print" command.



3. You can now print the entire map.

Option 2: Printing an enlarged portion of a map

- You will need to zoom-into the area of interest on the map. This
 process varies from browser to browser and among versions of
 the same browser. The quickest route for many browsers is to
 "right-click" on the map and select "Marquee Zoom". Use this
 tool to draw a window around the area of interest. The software
 should then zoom into that area.
- 2. When you have the area of interest on your screen, bring up the printing process as in Option1.
- 3. You will find an option in the Printing dialogue to Print "Current View". Select that option
- 4. It is likely that you will see a map of the area selected, but it will be quite small. In the print dialogue box you can select "Page Scaling." Select the option to "Fit to Printable Area."
- You may want to print one map with everything so that you have a copy of the legend.
